## Doran 360RV™ Tire Pressure Monitoring System Includes High Temperature Alarm

Cincinnati, Ohio – Doran Manufacturing has incorporated a high temperature alarm into their 360RV™ Tire Pressure Monitoring System for increased utility for RV owners. The new capability continuously monitors tire pressures and temperatures and will sound an audible alarm while displaying the specific tire position along with a “HOT” warning on the screen when the temperature exceeds 248°F.

“The high temperature warning is another way that we’ve added to the industry leading functionality of the Doran 360RV™ system and provide greater peace-of-mind to the RVer.” says Doran General Manager Jim Samocki. “Temperature information has always been transmitted in the data packets from our sensors and we started including the activation of the high temperature alarm in the Doran 360RV™ product line soon after the initial launch of the system. This additional monitoring and warning capability gives the driver a more complete picture of what is really happening with their tires, so that they can take appropriate actions to avert a blow-out, breakdown or accident.”



In addition to monitoring tire temperature, the Doran 360RV™ system monitors tire pressure for up to 36 tires for RV, trailer and tow-vehicle applications. A patent-pending Green Means GOOD™ indicator provides “at- a-glance” status updates to the driver. In addition to the standard Level 1 and Level 2 alarms at 12.5% and 25% below the programmed baseline tire pressure, a unique FastLeak™ warning is triggered with a drop in tire pressure of 2.8psi in less than 12 seconds.

The Doran 360RV™ is ideal for RVs of all sizes and configurations, including fifth-wheels. Installation can be accomplished without any special tools in about an hour, leaving no external antennas or exposed wires. A simple to understand and operate digital LCD screen display comes equipped with 4-way navigational buttons. The high-impact nylon sensors with potting material inside have passed rigorous SAE tests by an independent a2La accredited testing facility to ensure that they deliver the longest life and corrosion resistance on the market. Multiple mounting options including an adjustable pedestal mounting kit, visor clips and/or hook & loop fastening tape that allows the LCD screen to be mounted virtually anywhere.

Recent studies indicate that 90% of tire failures are caused by low tire inflation. Tires which were properly inflated just hours ago may be problematic due to changes in weather alone. This can lead to poor handling and braking, uneven tire wear, premature tire wear, blowouts and expensive breakdowns. The Doran 360RV™ eliminates these concerns by consistently checking tire pressure automatically and providing drivers with the peace-of-mind from knowing their family and investment is safe.
